

Environmental Policy

This document describes the Environmental Policy of Bio-Check (UK) Ltd and applies to all its activities.

Bio-Check (UK) develops, manufactures and market its own-branded products and distributes other product ranges from similar companies. Most of Bio-Check's products are related to supporting the "free from" food industry in their quest to supply high quality food products to food allergic and food intolerant consumers. Other products are designed to detect different food adulterants or contaminants. Bio-Check's main environmental impacts concern the provision of packaged testing kits, mainly comprised of plastic component bottles and cardboard/paper packaging, to its customers. It does not produce toxic waste or effluent.

However, it is recognised that the company's activities may have an adverse impact on our environment. It is our intention to manage our activities and minimise the negative impacts on the environment. The company will also, as far as reasonably practicable, manage its activities in ways that will benefit the environment whenever possible.

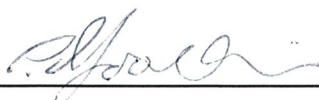
In order to achieve this, the company has adopted the following key objectives:

1. Promote sound environmental management policies where appropriate;
2. As a minimum, to comply with the requirements of all relevant legislation;
3. Make efficient and environmentally responsible use of resources;
4. Minimise waste production as far as is practicable; re-use/recycle waste as appropriate;
5. Prevent pollution wherever possible; in all of the "Instructions For Use" provided with its products the company has a recycling section asking users to recycle plastics/paper/card, most of which are readily recyclable, that remain when the kit has been used;
6. To try to use responsible suppliers and aim to purchase environmentally friendly products wherever possible; cardboard packaging is increasingly being sourced from FSC regulated (managed, sustainable) resources and is recyclable. Dyes used are Low Migration and the safest available.
7. To support the professional development of our staff to ensure they can contribute to improving our environmental performance;
8. Aim to continually improve the environmental performance through reviewing this Policy and setting environmental improvement targets.

While the company accepts responsibility for implementing its Policy, individuals are also required to abide by company rules and requirements made both under this Policy and any other statutory legislation.
